Insights is an independent school that provides specialised education and training for children and young people who are experiencing difficulties within mainstream learning environments and social settings. We provide centre based provision and preventative packages to support pupils/students in school.

We offer

Tailor made educational packages.

Individualised tuition from 1 - 30 hours per week.

Assessment of learning needs (contributing to statutory assessment).

A range of short accredited courses for students aged 14 -19.

Educational visits, trips and residentials.

A range of vocational training and work experience opportunities.

Regular progress reviews and reports.

The programmes have been designed so that they can be an integral part of any preventative strategy.

Criteria for accessing our programmes

Pupils/students should be aged 7-19 years (younger pupils will be considered).

Referrals can be made by schools, the local authority (or parents/carers for after school and holiday programmes).

Encourage learners to become emotionally literate.

Enable learners to develop confidence, self discipline, and positive self esteem.

Enable learners to become self-motivated and independent learners.

Training and conference rooms (also available for hire).

We use the latest technology and e-learning resources to enable pupils/students to direct their own learning. There are also software packages to support students with Dyslexia, visual and hearing impairment.

Light and dark sensory rooms.

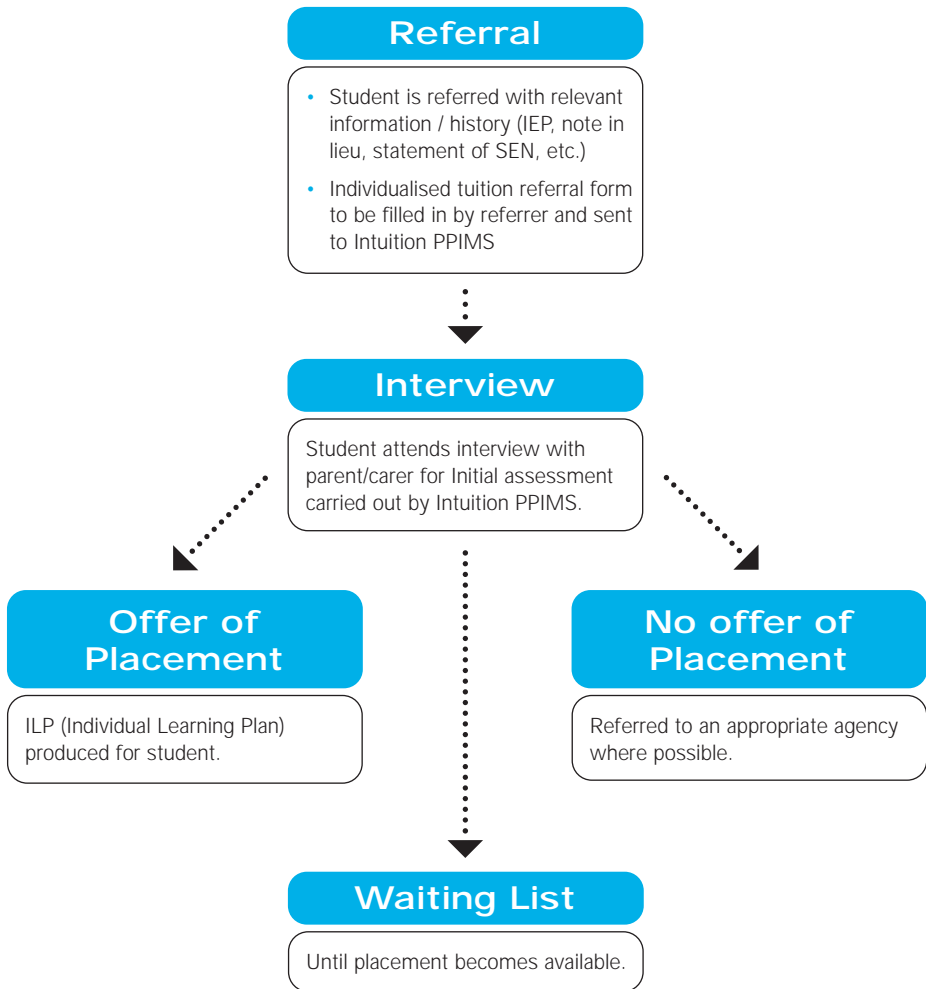
Life skill studio.
